In the garden’s hush, God’s voice broke the silence with a startling question: “Where are you?” It can be a haunting question! Surely God knew exactly where Adam was. The real question was whether Adam knew where Adam was. Fear and fig leaves signaled the fractured fellowships. Did Adam know how far he had fallen?

Sin does that to us. It fractures relationships and threatens fellowship. But God’s question to Adam was revealing. It would signal to Adam and Eve, and to you and me, the character of our maker and our redeemer. Our life-giving God always pursues. “Where are you?” says, “I care where you are.” And it says, “No matter where you are, I’m not far away.”

When God asks, “Where are you?” he is saying, “If you are broken, I will restore.”
